

**CERTIFICATION OF COMPETENT PERSONS FOR FIRE EXTINGUISHER
MAINTENANCE IN COMPLIANCE WITH GREEK LEGISLATION.**

1. PURPOSE OF SERVICE

The proposed services include the assessment and certification of individuals who serve as technical supervisors in Recognized Fire Extinguisher Maintenance Companies.

The service shall be performed in compliance with the contract entered between Bureau Veritas and the Client and/or the Bureau Veritas General Terms and Conditions of Service.

2. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

The scope of the service includes the evaluation and certification of individuals serving as technical supervisors in recognized fire extinguisher maintenance companies according to Greek Legislation.

3. APPLICABLE STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS

This approval will be issued subject to compliance with the Greek Legislation specified in:

- ISO 17024:2012
- MD 618/43 FEK B 52/2005
- MD 17230/671 FEK B 1218/2005

The particular conditions of the contract specify the reference framework chosen and the conditions of service of the equipment for which approval is envisaged.

4. PERFORMANCE OF SERVICE

The BV ensures that:

- That the candidate has submitted a complete application with all the required documents in accordance with the certification scheme.
- Conducts a review and determines whether the candidate has the qualifications to participate in the evaluation process.
- The body defines the evaluation process based on the certification scheme.
- Has conducted a 24-hour training program.
- Conducts the examinations in accordance with the evaluation process.
- The body makes the final decision on certification based on the candidate's performance.

5. APPLICANT'S COMMITMENT

When signing the contract, the APPLICANT makes the following commitments:

- To be admitted, the applicant must submit the necessary documents to Bureau Veritas in digital format (PDF). Engineers must provide their diplomas, while technicians must submit public records from the public insurance agency to verify their three years of experience in the field.

6. BUREAU VERITAS DELIVERABLES

If all requirements are met, the certificate for the competent person is issued upon successful completion of the examination.

The certificate and their associated annexes are provided as a single electronic copy (PDF) and, unless otherwise specified, in Greek. They are sent via email, serving as an equivalent to a delivery note. The certificates are considered accepted unless written comments are received within two weeks of delivery.

7. PERIOD OF VALIDITY

The approval granted is valid for five (5) years as long as:

- The relative Greek legislation used for the achievement of the qualification is applicable according the official journal of the Hellenic Republic.
- The qualification of the competent person remains valid under the conditions for which the approval was granted.
- The qualification of the competent person has not expired.
- The certificate has not been revoked, and the competent person performs their duties in compliance with the law.

8. RENEWAL

Recertification is required every five years and must be completed before the expiration of the current certificate.

9. LIMITS OF THE PRESENT SERVICE

Bureau Veritas' responsibility shall not be engaged in case of the certificate is misused or misapplied, such as when used outside of the approval range.

Qualification certificate cannot be considered as final approval for specific regulation (e.g. MD 618/43 requirements for Recognized Companies).

10. PREREQUISITES

Applicants must have the formal qualifications required by Greek legislation as described below:

- To hold an engineering degree or to hold an IEK degree in a relevant field or to have 3 years proven working experience.
- To have successfully completed 24-hour training including examination. The examination must have been conducted from an examination body under ISO 17024 accreditation.
